

HAROLD ALFRED WHITE

Born on the 10th September 1907 in Portsmouth, one of the 4 surviving children (out of 10) of William and Annie White, he was known in the family as Bob.

Married Mabel Lily Boyce at St. Mary Portsea on the 15th April 1933.

Only child Alan born on the 23rd December 1934

Harold was an Electrical Mains Draughtsman and as such may have been excused conscription especially if he was employed in the Dockyard. The position as a Special Constable may have been his form of "War work".

The family lived at 66 Talbot Rd and on the night of 10th January 1941 the house took a direct hit. It seems likely that all of them were killed outright. The ARP reports show that the bodies were found in the grounds of the next-door house the following day.

Harold, Mabel and Alan were all buried together in Kingston cemetery on the 18th January.
